



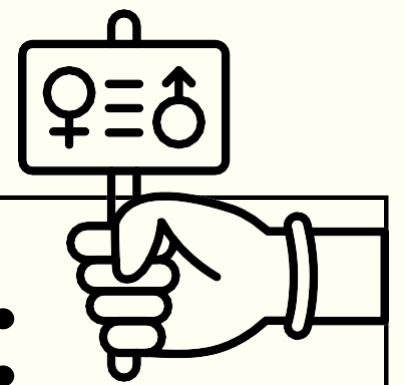

Course Modules

Module 1: Introduction to Gender and Politics (2 hrs.)

- Defining the key terms (1 Hr.)
- Gender
- Sex
- Gender Identity
- Sexual Orientation
- Political Participation
- Representation etc
- Exploration of the historical and theoretical frameworks of Gender & Politics
- Activity – Identifying how gender shapes and is shaped by Political Systems and Processes (1 Hr.)

Module 2: Gender & Political Representation (2Hrs.)

- Analysis of the underrepresentation of women and other marginalized genders in government
- Examination of the barriers to political participation for different genders
- Strategies for increasing women's political representation

Module 3: Gender & Policy (3Hrs.)

- Exploration of how Gender is embedded in different policy areas such as education, healthcare, the economy, and the environment
- Analysis of the gendered impacts of different policies
- Case studies of gender-related public policies- Advocating for policies that promote gender equality and justice

Course Modules

Module 4: Gender-Based Violence & Politics (2Hrs.)

- Examination of different forms of gender-based violence, including intimate partner violence, sexual assault, and human trafficking
- Exploration of the political dimensions of gender-based violence, such as state responses and prevention strategies
- Advocacy for policies and programmes that address and prevent gender-based violence
- The role of gender in political parties
- The impact of gender on elections
- Campaign strategies for women candidates
- Gender quotas and other forms of affirmative action

Module 5 Engaging Students in Gender and Politics (2 Hrs.)

- Teaching Strategies for incorporating gender analysis into social studies curriculum
- Creating a classroom environment that is inclusive and respectful of diverse genders and identities
- Encouraging students to become active participants in their communities and advocates for gender equality

Module 6: Intersectional Approaches to Gender & Politics (3Hrs.)

- Recognition of how gender intersects with other identities, such as sexuality, to shape political experiences and outcomes
- Explore the concept of Intersectionality and its application to the analysis of politics.
- Development of strategies for building inclusive and equitable political systems and movements
